



Youth Impact Jeunesse offers a range of programs and services including residential, community outreach, and Youth QUEST Central (drop-in centre for at-risk and homeless youth). Our organization is responding to COVID-19 across all of our programs. The health and safety of our staff, youth, volunteers, and the broader community is our top priority. Based on various government announcements, Youth Impact has adopted the following service changes:

- Youth Impact Jeunesse will continue to operate all of its residential programs as they are essential services.
- Youth QUEST Central will alter service delivery effective 5pm today to adhere to the recommendations regarding social distancing. The centre will be closed to the general public until further notice. Youth can obtain food, hygiene products, and other necessities at the front door. - All outreach services will be suspended in the community and support will be delivered via telephone.
- The Open Doors Learning Centre is closed until further notice.
