**Youth Impact Jeunesse hosted Coldest Night of the Year in Moncton for the 9th consecutive year on February 26th. The event took place in 165 cities across Canada supporting charities that work with the hurt, hungry, and homeless.**

We are thrilled to report this year's event raised the highest amount in our history, surpassing our second highest year by over \$20,000.
