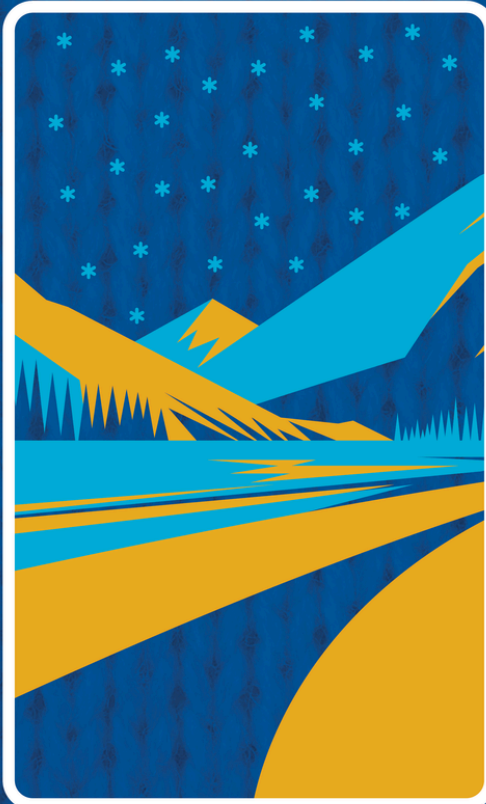
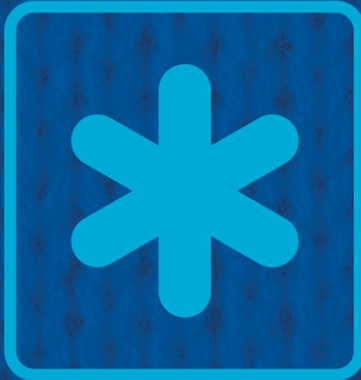

“Transitional Housing was the first place I ever felt real peace. It's been really nice to come home and think about my future instead of just getting through the day. It's given me the space to try new things and the confidence to work on myself.
