

From Surviving to Stability


Not long ago, Spenser carried everything he owned in a backpack. He moved from couch to couch, trying not to overstay his welcome. Each day, he went to school exhausted and distracted, quietly worrying about where he would sleep that night.

When Spenser connected with our Transitional Housing Program, the first thing he received was something many of us take for granted: a safe place to stay. A key. A door that locked. A place where his belongings stayed exactly where he left them.

With stability came change. Regular meals. Better sleep. The ability to focus at school. He began spending time at Youth QUEST Central, where staff and mentors learned his name and encouraged him to think about his future.

The transformation didn't happen overnight, but slowly Spenser moved from surviving to planning for what comes next.

This is the impact you make possible. Because of your support, young people experiencing homelessness can find safety, stability, and hope for the future.
